The Direct Debit Guarantee

This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme. The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society. If the amounts to be paid or the payment date changes Derbyshire Wildlife Trust will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If an error is made by Derbyshire Wildlife Trust or your Bank or Building Society you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid. Gift Aid

You have probably heard that the Government has recently made it easier for charities to reclaim income tax from the Inland Revenue. By agreeing to the statement below, Derbyshire Wildlife Trust can reclaim the tax on your subscriptions and donations made to Derbyshire Wildlife Trust. Your subscription/donation will then be worth almost one third more to Derbyshire Wildlife Trust, at no extra cost to you.

Although there is now no minimum amount for Gift Aid donations and subscriptions, to be eligible for Gift Aid you must pay an amount of income tax or capital gains tax equal to the tax we reclaim on your donations (currently 28p on every £1 you give). Please do consider doing this - it really makes an enormous difference.

1. If your declaration covers subscriptions/donations you may make in the future:
 - Please notify the charity if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity ~ it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and / or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you must cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you could claim tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
