

A Snapshot of some of our KPIs (as of December 2025)

- 665 community photos have been taken using the 10 fixed point photography posts on site,

- We have led or taken part in 63 events with approximately 4,180 attendees,

- We have hosted 50 volunteering sessions with over 405 volunteers in attendance (note some of these are regular people attending different sessions). An additional 41 volunteers have signed up to volunteer or be upskilled to deliver wildlife monitoring and conservation activities onsite as part of a new volunteering opportunity,

- We have taken part in or hosted 28 knowledge sharing sessions to over 840 people from over 39 different organisations, including a visit from the Chief Scientific Advisor for the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero,

- 165 people have taken part in wellbeing walks, and 229 people have taken part in wellbeing activities on site,

- 56 Forest School sessions have taken place through the project,

- 15 Junior Rangers and 3 Junior Ranger Leaders are meeting monthly onsite,

- 13 children completed the level 3 Leading a Project for Positive Change qualification, and 8 children are currently undertaking it to become local nature champions
